The women's boutique gave 10% of sales from September 25th and 26th to offset the costs of mailing parents information for their children to participate in the Children's Christmas Project. Children of Ashe County living in poverty will be given gifts purchased by many groups and individuals, allowing the Christmas spirit to be in a home when circumstances would otherwise not permit it.

Libby's is a boutique full of clothing for women, as well as a source for distinct jewelry. Libby Cockerham has been helping customers one-on-one since she opened the store in 2002. Libby's does fashion shows and fashion seminars for groups and retailers. Services offered include layaway, alterations, shipping, and a computer system that allows tracking for gift purchases. Libby's is located at 205B Shamrock Square in Jefferson.

Ashe County Partnership for Children is a non-profit organization that provides programs and services for families and children in Ashe County. They fund or directly run various programs such as: Smart Start programs to benefit children ages birth through five and their families; Domestic Violence prevention and awareness services, including shelter services; a Family Literacy program with transportation, child care and family support; and Family Support Services offering playgroups, parenting support and education.
